

## PRAYER GUIDE FOR 2026 SEVEN DAYS OF FASTING AND PRAYER

### 2026: My Year of Prophetic Fulfillment

Theme Verse: ***Joshua 21:45 (NIV) — 45 Not one of all the LORD's good promises to Israel failed; every one was fulfilled.***

Theme Hymns: ***Standing on the Promises of God/Great is Thy Faithfulness***

**Joel 1:14 (NIV)**

*Declare a holy fast; call a sacred assembly. Summon the elders and all who live in the land to the house of the Lord your God, and cry out to the Lord.*

**Joel 2:12 (NIV)**

*“Even now,” declares the Lord, “return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning.”*

**Thursday, January 1: Thanksgiving and Alignment for Prophetic Fulfillment; Emphasis on Thanksgiving, Confession, Repentance, Renewal, and Consecration.**

**PRAYER LEADER: PASTOR JOHN**

**Scripture:** Joshua 21:45, Psalm 103:1–5; Lamentations 3:22–23; Psalm 51:10–12; Joshua 21:45; Joel 1:14; 2:12

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Offer gratitude to God for His faithfulness in past promises, as exemplified in Joshua 21:45. Thank God for His help in the ages past.

#### Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for life, salvation, the church, and the privilege to enter a new prophetic season.
2. Thank God for past victories, answered prayers, and preserved lives.
3. Declare that this year shall not fail or miscarry in your life or in the church.
4. Ask God to align every member, family, and ministry with His prophetic agenda.
5. Pray that no word spoken by God concerning the church and members shall fail in Jesus' name.
6. Pray for personal and corporate confession of sins within the church, seeking forgiveness for any hindrances to prophetic fulfillment.
7. Intercede for renewal of minds and spirits among members, that they may align with God's prophetic word.
8. Ask for divine consecration of the church body, setting it apart for holy service and growth.
9. Petition for dedication to God's purposes, enabling the church to expand in influence and attendance.

**Confession and Repentance:** Reflect on Joel 1:14 and 2:12, repenting of complacency and seeking heartfelt return to God.

### **Declarations:**

- Declare Joshua 21:45 over the church: “Not one promise from God will fail; all shall be fulfilled in this year of prophetic fulfillment.”
- “Every good thing the Lord has spoken over me and this church shall surely come to pass.”
- “This is my year of prophetic fulfillment; delay is broken in Jesus’ name!”

### **Friday, January 2: Focus on Church Leadership; Spiritual Authority and Ministries**

**PRAYER LEADER: MINISTER DANIEL CAROTHERS**

**Scripture:** Hebrews 13:17, Isaiah 11:2, Isaiah 32:1; Colossians 1:9–10; 1 Timothy 2:1–2; Joel 1:14; 2:12.

### **Praise and Thanksgiving:**

- Thank God for the leaders He has appointed, acknowledging His sovereignty in guiding them toward fulfillment of promises.

### **Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for wisdom, strength, and protection for church leadership, that they may lead with prophetic insight.
2. Intercede for the vitality of church ministries, seeking divine empowerment for effective service and growth.
3. Ask for victory over the challenges leaders and ministries face, ensuring alignment with the theme of prophetic fulfillment.
4. Petition for increased faith among leaders to model trust in God’s unfailing promises.
5. Pray for pastors, ministers, and all church leaders for fresh oil and grace.
6. Ask for wisdom, discernment, humility, and boldness for church leaders.
7. Pray against burnout, discouragement, error, and distraction among leaders.
8. Declare divine protection over leaders and their families.
9. Pray that leadership decisions will advance God’s prophetic agenda in 2026 and beyond in Jesus’ name.

- **Confession and Repentance:** Based on Joel 1:14 and 2:12, confess any shortcomings and repent for areas that you identified.

### **Declaration:**

- Affirm Joshua 21:45: “Every promise to the church leadership and ministries will be fulfilled without fail.”
- “Our leaders are clothed with wisdom and power.”
- “Through our leadership, God’s promises are fulfilled in Jesus name.”

### **Saturday, January 3: Focus on Church Growth, Expansion, and Church Attendance**

**PRAYER LEADER: MINISTER TAYO THOMAS**

**Scripture:** Acts 2:47, Isaiah 54:2–3; Isaiah 60:1–5, Matthew 16:18; Joel 1:14; 2:12

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Express thanks for the church, praising God for His plans of expansion as per His promises for His church.

**Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for numerical and spiritual growth in the church, attracting new members through divine invitation.
2. Intercede for physical and territorial expansion, including new programs or initiatives.
3. Ask for increased attendance and commitment from members, fostering a vibrant church community.
4. Petition for victory in outreach efforts, leading to prophetic fulfillment in community impact.
5. Pray for supernatural numerical and spiritual growth.
6. Ask God to draw souls into the church daily.
7. Pray against stagnation, division, and spiritual dryness.
8. Declare supernatural increase in church attendance, follow-up, and retention.
9. Pray for church expansion in all areas of the church ministry.
10. Pray for Numerical, spiritual, and structural growth

**Confession and Repentance:** Drawing from Joel 1:14 and 2:12, repent of any apathy toward growth and seek renewal in evangelistic zeal.

**Declaration:** Proclaim Joshua 21:45: “*God’s promises for church growth and expansion will all come to pass in this year in Jesus name.*”

**Declarations:**

- “The church is growing without limit.”
- “We arise and shine; the nations come to our light!”
- Father, increase our church on every side.
- Draw multitudes into our services supernaturally.
- Remove every barrier to church attendance and growth.
- Let every ministry flourish and expand.
- Establish permanent expansion opportunities in Jesus name.

**Sunday, January 4: Focus on the Increase of financial resources and the provision for the church and all church members.**

**PRAYER LEADER: MINISTER MATTHEW JORGBO**

**Scripture:** Haggai 2:8, Philippians 4:19, Deuteronomy 8:18; Malachi 3:10; Joel 2:25–26; Joel 1:14; 2:12; Daniel 11:32.

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Give thanks for God’s provision, recognizing Him as the source of all abundance in line with His faithful promises.

**Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for financial breakthroughs for the church, enabling ministry expansion and debt-free operations.
2. Intercede for members' financial increase, that they may experience prosperity and generosity.
3. Ask for wisdom in stewardship, aligning resources with prophetic purposes.
4. Petition for protection against economic challenges, securing victory through faith.
5. Pray for financial increase for the church and members.
6. Ask God to bless tithes, offerings, and kingdom investments.
7. Pray for open doors, promotions, businesses, and jobs for members.
8. Pray that God breaks cycles of debt and lack.
9. Break the spirit of lack, debt, and financial struggle.
10. Declare supernatural provision and abundance.
11. Pray that God opens financial doors for the church and its members.
12. Pray that God blesses members with jobs, businesses, and promotions.
13. Pray for God to restore wasted years and lost opportunities.
14. Pray that God releases supernatural provision for church projects

**Confession and Repentance:** Inspired by Joel 1:14 and 2:12, confess mismanagement of resources and repent for lack of trust in God's provision.

**Declaration:**

- Declare Joshua 21:45: "Not one financial promise from God will fail; all shall be fulfilled for the church and its members."
- "We prosper to fund the gospel."
- "The Lord supplies all our needs according to His riches!"

**Monday, January 5: Faith, Victory, Spiritual Warfare, Deliverance**

**PRAYER LEADER: SISTER THERESE ARNOLD**

**Scripture: Colossians 2:15, Luke 10:19, 2 Corinthians 10:3–5**

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Praise God for victories already won, thanking Him for strengthening faith through His unchanging promises.

**Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for deepened faith among members, enabling them to claim prophetic fulfillments.
2. Intercede for victory over spiritual battles, both personal and corporate.
3. Pray for deliverance from spiritual bondage, freeing individuals to pursue God's plans.
4. Petition for spiritual growth, transforming lives through renewed dedication.
5. Declare victory over every satanic opposition to prophetic fulfillment.
6. Pray for deliverance for members in spiritual bondage.
7. Break ancestral, generational, and demonic strongholds in the name of Jesus Christ.
8. Pray against fear, depression, addiction, and oppression.
9. Pray for the Release of freedom, peace, and dominion over every life in Jesus name.

**Confession and Repentance:** From Joel 1:14 and 2:12, repent of doubt and bondage, seeking liberation and consecration.

**Declaration:**

- Affirm Joshua 21:45: “Every promise of faith, victory, and deliverance will be fully realized.”
- “By the blood of Jesus, we overcome!”
- “Every chain is broken; victory is ours!”

**Tuesday, January 6: Emphasis on Healing and Spiritual Renewal; Themes of Healing, Faith, and Family Restoration**

**PRAYER LEADER: MINISTER TUTU BAINDA**

**Scripture:** Jeremiah 30:17, Hebrews 11:6, Psalm 127:3; Luke 4:18; Joel 1:14; 2:12.

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Thank God for His healing power, acknowledging restoration as part of His fulfilled promises.

**Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for physical, emotional, and spiritual healing among members and the community.
2. Intercede for divine restoration of lost opportunities, health, and relationships.
3. Pray for renewal in areas of brokenness, aligning with the church’s prophetic theme.
4. Petition for increased faith to receive healing and restoration.
5. Pray for divine healing—physical, emotional, and mental.
6. Release healing over terminal and chronic conditions.
7. Pray for increased faith among members.
8. Pray for marriages—restoration, peace, and fruitfulness.
9. Pray for singles—godly marriages; for the barren—children.
10. Pray for Healing for every sickness and disease.
11. Pray for Deliverance of those in spiritual bondage and addiction.
12. Pray for Release godly marriages for singles.
13. Pray for blessing of the womb for the barren.
14. Pray for Restoration of broken families and relationships

**Confession and Repentance:** Based on Joel 1:14 and 2:12, confess unbelief in healing and repent for neglecting holistic well-being.

**Declaration:**

- Proclaim Joshua 21:45: “God’s promises of healing and restoration will not fail; all shall be accomplished.”
- “By His stripes, we are healed.”
- “None shall be barren in this church!”

**Wednesday, January 7: Concentrate on marriages, fertility, and overall fulfillment; spiritual growth, ministries, thanksgiving, and prophetic completion and fulfillment of God's promises.**

**PRAYER LEADER: PASTOR JOHN & MINISTER ALICE OJEWOLE**

**Scriptures: Psalm 136; Ephesians 4:11–13, Joel 2:28, Joshua 21:45; Habakkuk 2:3; Joel 1:14; 2:12; Psalm 37:5; Proverbs 3:5–6; 2 Corinthians 6:14; Psalm 27:14; James 1:5.**

**Praise and Thanksgiving:** Offer gratitude for the church, church members, and family blessings, and praise God for His commitment to fulfill promises in our personal lives. Thank God for the completion of seven days of fasting and prayer.

**Intercessory Prayer Points:**

1. Pray for godly marriages for singles, guiding them toward prophetic partnerships.
2. Pray for God's Favor in Relationships.
3. Pray for Wisdom and Discernment
4. Intercede for children for the barren, invoking fruitfulness as per God's word.
5. Pray for the strengthening of existing marriages and families within the church.
6. Petition for comprehensive spiritual growth and church-wide victory in all areas.
7. Pray for spiritual maturity and hunger for God.
8. Pray for all church ministries—effectiveness and impact.
9. Ask for revival, fresh fire, and outpouring of the Holy Spirit.
10. Declare fulfillment of every prophecy spoken over the church and
11. Thank God for answered prayers.
12. Declare fulfillment of prophecies over the church and members.
13. Pray to cancel delays, stagnation, and disappointment.
14. Seal every blessing released during the fast.
15. Commit the rest of the year into God's hands.
16. Dedicate the rest of the year to God.

**Confession and Repentance:** Drawing from Joel 1:14 and 2:12, repent of doubting God's word and promises, repent of relational shortcomings, and seek consecration in family matters.

**Declaration:**

- Declare Joshua 21:45: "In this year of prophetic fulfillment, every promise for marriages, fruitfulness, and church prosperity will be realized without exception."
- "Not one good promise of God shall fail!"
- "This year, all comes to pass in Jesus' name!"
- "According to Joshua 21:45, there shall be no failure, no delay, and no denial."
- Every good thing the Lord has spoken concerning my life, my family, and my church shall surely come to pass.
- This is my year of prophetic fulfillment, in Jesus' mighty name. Amen!"
- "*There shall be no failure of any good thing the Lord has spoken concerning us—ALL SHALL COME TO PASS!*"
